




An Invitation to Those Who Labor


Matthew 11:25-30

John 6:35, 44, 37

V. 35 *And Jesus said to them, "I am the bread of life. He who comes to Me shall never hunger, and he who believes in Me shall never thirst.*

V. 44, *No one can come to Me unless the Father who sent Me draws him; and I will raise him up at the last day.*

V. 47, *Most assuredly, I say to you, he who believes in Me has everlasting life.*
