Hebrews 11:1-6




# I. *It is A Timeless Pattern.*

Genesis 3:15

(Speaking to the Serpent)

*And I will put enmity between you and the woman,  
And between your seed and her Seed; He shall bruise  
your head, And you shall bruise His heel.”*

## II. God called Abraham to *faith-filled worship*.

A. Each faith-filled worship calls for action.

B. It is not difficult to draw this similarity.

*<sup>24</sup>And let us consider one another in order to stir up love and good works,*

*<sup>25</sup>not forsaking the assembling of ourselves together, as is the manner of some, but exhorting one another, and so much the more as you see the Day approaching. (Heb. 10:24-25).*

(1) at a certain time

(2) at a certain place

(3) with a certain group, and

(4) for very certain reasons. **Do not forsake it!**

# III. God called Moses to lead Israel to *delivering worship*.

## A. Delivering worship is that which frees a man.

Ex. 3:11-12, *“But Moses said to God, ‘Who am I, that I should go to Pharaoh and bring the Israelites out of Egypt?’ and God said, ‘I will be with you. And this will be the sign to you that it is I who have sent you: When you have brought the people out of Egypt, you will worship God on this mountain.”*

## B. It is in our worshiping of God that we truly find ourselves.

1 Tim. 2:8, *I desire therefore that the men pray everywhere, lifting up holy hands, without wrath and doubting.*

# IV. See God calling Isaiah to *purifying worship.*

A. Purifying worship when a man's *waiting* in the presence of God.

Isa. 6:5, "Woe to me!" I cried. 'I am ruined! For I am a man of unclean lips, and I live among a people of unclean lips'"

B. That is not talking about a vision of God.



V. See the church born in  
*empowering worship.* (Acts 2).

A. The outpouring of the Holy Spirit.

B. Worship also sustains this divine empowering.

*“Keep on being filled with the Holy Spirit: (Eph. 5:18).*




# VI. Present Yourself to God.

## A. No text in the Bible makes this clearer:

*I beseech you therefore, brethren, by the mercies of God, that you present your bodies a living sacrifice, holy, acceptable to God, which is your reasonable service.*

*<sup>2</sup>And do not be conformed to this world, but be transformed by the renewing of your mind, that you may prove what is that good and acceptable and perfect will of God. (Rom. 12:1-2)*

*—this is your spiritual act of worship. (NIV)*
